ENROLLMENT AGREEMENT Addendum
WSET Level 3 Wines Course

International Wine Center has received a special temporary exemption from the NY State Board of Education, effective from March 30th until the time when NYC is able to re-open for business. Under this special exemption, IWC will deliver the course **“WSET Level 3 Wines Course”** virtually via a Zoom webinar that will enable students to actively participate.

The webinar classes for **“WSET Level 3 Wines Course”** will cover the remaining theory portion of the courses that started before IWC suspended its classes as well as new classes that begin after March 13. As soon as possible when NYC is again open for business, IWC will schedule in-person tasting classes corresponding to theory sessions that were delivered via webinar, will resume normal in-person sessions for ongoing classes, and will schedule exams.

Classes will occur on from **6:00pm to 7:30 pm**, on the same day of the week on which the course began.

For the ongoing **AC 120** the schedule is as follows: **Tuesday evenings, April 14, 21, 28; May 5 and May 12 from 6:00 to 7:30pm**. The Zoom webinar sessions will cover the following remaining classes:

- Session 11 - Premium Red regions of North America, South Africa, Australia and New Zealand
- Session 12 - Premium White regions of North America, Australia and New Zealand
- Session 13 - South America, Regional specialties of the world
- Session 14 - Sparkling wines
- Session 15 - Fortified wines

For **AC 220** the webinar schedule will be from **10:30am to 12 noon**. For future courses, the webinar schedule will be from **6:00 to 7:30 pm** on the dates indicated on the course schedule published at www.internationalwinecenter.com.

For all Level 3 Wines courses conducted via webinar, additional tasting sessions will be scheduled to complete your coursework. These in-person classes and your exam will occur as soon as possible once NYC is open for business again and IWC is able to conduct in-person sessions.
